New Expense Contracts

MOVED by Tim Hanna and SUPPORTED by Raul Gonzales that the Finance Committee recommends that the Board of Directors of Community Mental Health Authority of Clinton, Eaton, and Ingham Counties authorize CMHA-CEI to enter into the following new expense contracts based on the fact that the information has been reviewed and the proposals are in line with agency responsibilities:

Expense Contract: Boiler Replacement - 838 Louisa Street

John Peiffer presented two items for new boilers. He clarified that at Louisa St., there is a much larger boiler room and two boilers will fit, which will be more efficient in cycling them on and off. John went on to clarify the boilers have 20-year warranties. The two boilers for Louisa St. will cost a total of \$36,525.00.

Expense Contract: Boiler Replacement 606 Shiawassee Street The total cost for the new boiler is \$48,140.

Expense Contract Amendment: Iris Telehealth

Sara Lurie presented this item with our telehealth contractor. Due to some retirements, we are needing to add some additional child psychiatry and backfill some of the adult psychiatry services.

Medicaid Revenue Update

Sue Panetta presented the update through December 2022. We continue to run over budget because of the continuation of the PHE. This has been extended again, but the recertification has been unbundled from the PHE and those will begin April 1. Sue said the first quarter financials should be ready soon, which will provide a clearer picture of the figures presented tonight. The total is running \$2.4 over budget for the quarter.

Joe noted that we will have 14 months to recertify as many folks as possible that are still eligible for Medicaid. We won't see the drop off in Medicaid for many months after that, and it will be a gradual decline.
