# Updated: COVID-19 Vaccine Eligibility and Resources

Beginning Monday, 3/8 MDHHS is expanding the vaccine eligibility group to include Michiganders age 50 and older with medical conditions or disabilities and caregiver family members and guardians who care for children with special health care needs.

- **\*NEW\* COVID-19 Hotline:** Residents who don't have access to the internet or who need assistance navigating the vaccine scheduling process can call the COVID-19 Hotline at 888-535-6136 (press 1), Monday through Friday from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m., Saturday and Sunday, 8 a.m. to 1 p.m.
- **Rite Aid:** Rite Aid is now authorized to immunize Michigan residents in the following priority groups: age 65+, healthcare workers, long-term care residents and staff, pharmacy staff, or public health employees. Use the following link to view vaccine appointment availability at area Rite Aid locations and schedule an appt: [Click to View](#)
- **2-1-1:** Michigan residents within the prioritization category and without access to the internet or needing further assistance finding information on vaccination or scheduling an appointment, if available, can dial 2-1-1 to speak to a 2-1-1 specialist.
- **Updated\* McLaren:** McLaren is now inviting existing patients 65 and older to sign up to receive the COVID-19 vaccine. If you are a McLaren patient 65 and older, you can use the link below to submit your interest form. McLaren will contact patients who submit this form when vaccines become available in the coming weeks. Complete the vaccine interest form here: [Click to complete](#).
- **Meijer:** Meijer has partnered with the State of Michigan to help administer COVID-19 vaccines. Anyone can pre-register for the COVID-19 vaccine with Meijer and they will notify you if they are able to provide you with the vaccine.
