#### <u>New Business</u>

Raul wanted to reiterate again the issue with the opioid crisis in the tri-county area. He noted there is an abuse issue with buprenorphine, which CEI prescribes. Dr. Stanley wanted to note that CEI doesn't black box medications because children might get their hands on them. She went on to say right now, buprenorphine is one of our best medication options, and it's unfortunate that its being abused. Ideally, we would have more methadone clinics in the area, as well. That being said, there are several initiatives in the area sharing resources and data on overdoses in the region.
