Overview:

Community Mental Health Authority of Clinton, Eaton, and Ingham Counties (CMHA-CEI) is seeking qualified Residential Providers for placement on our panel for the potential operation of any of the following: Community Living Support Services, 4-12 bed specialized AFCs, 6 bed waiver homes, and Personal Residential Homes (PRH's) of varying sizes for the residents of Clinton, Eaton, and Ingham Counties. Community Living Support Services, PRH's, and Waiver Homes require the arrangement of supports to maintain individuals with intellectual disabilities, mental illness, and/or co-occurring substance use diagnoses in these residential setting. Program components are to include residential supports and community based programming following individual Person Centered Planning processes.

The earliest start date for any contract established with a provider will be from October 1, 2018. Contracts will extend to September 30, 2021. Renewal of any contract will be based on an objective performance evaluation at the end of each contract period.
